Subject: Trail Usage Signage Policy

Preamble: The Bruce County Highways Committee has jurisdiction over the former CNR rail corridor from Huron County through Mildmay, Walkerton, Paisley to Port Elgin and then south-westerly to the BNPD. The County has approved this signage policy to ensure trail signage that is consistent with the approved Risk Management Policy.

Policy Statement:

All trail signage will comply with the recommendations of Bruce Grey Trails Network (BGTN) Master Plan.

Local Trail Groups may wish to establish and maintain a Trail Head/ Kiosk that clearly identifies the whole trail system as well as a simple map of the trail.

Signs to be included are:

1. BCRTMC Logo
2. BGTN Trail Etiquette
3. OFSC/OATV logos (if appropriate)
4. 911 Emergency Access location
5. Stop
6. Stop Ahead
7. Trail Closed
8. Speed Limit
9. Slow
10. Bridge
11. Intersection ahead
12. Intersection
13. Trail Ends
14. Permitted Uses
15. No trespassing symbol - Club Members Only/No Unauthorized Motorized Use

Size and location of signs will be consistent with OFSC signage standards. OFSC standards may be found in Appendix E.
